Coloured wall lamp, made with motorcycle heat covers. To be installed in pairs.


Post Design is highlighted here by a new design of the recovered pieces, which change both in function and in cultural references

The FISH-LAMP lamp was born with the discovery at a scrapyards of interesting parts such as heat covers of scooters silencers. After having cleaned them I looked for an alternative design and a new and eye-catching function: the shapes is suggestive of something marine and aerodynamic. I opted for a wall lamp unit, inspired by electric fishes which emit light. And thus the fish-lamps were created, to be mounted in a vertical or horizontal sequence as two colorful fish. The tails are made from kitchen ladles, while the eyes are crafted from ball bearings.






